

Where do we work?

The Archbishop's Delegate for Culture in Malta has embarked on a new project which seeks to establish a new strategy and vision for the Catholic Institute in Floriana. The building seeks to create a bridge between the performing and visual arts, through a new infrastructure, artistic programme and various initiatives. It is the goal of Mgr. Claude Portelli, the Curia's Delegate for Culture, to create a space for youths, artists, creatives and the general public to witness the beauty that the

arts can bring to society and to create an opportunity for an encounter with creative collaboration across various disciplines.

How does the application process work?

We hold open auditions, for anyone aged between 16 and 40 years of age.

The auditions will be live, in front of a panel of at least 3 industry professionals. We will be looking for potential and a willingness to learn.

How much will it cost?

Thanks to support from Arts Council Malta, Rotary Club La Valette Malta and The Farsons Foundation we are able to offer all training (weekly sessions and weekend masterclasses) for the first year at a fee of €100 per month.

Total fee (€800) may be paid in instalments or in one payment. More information about course content, dates and times of classes and fees will be sent upon request.
